Medication Therapy Management Program Glossary

1. **“Drug Utilization Review”** or **“DUR”** – For the purposes of this Exhibit B-14 for MTMP, DUR means the NCPDP rejection message via POS for an MTMP DUR edit.
2. **“Intervention”** means review of the MTM Covered Persons medication history and/or consultation with the MTM Covered Person and/or the MTM Covered Person’s Prescribing Provider to promote the appropriate use of the MTM Covered Person’s medications for the purpose of improving the MTM Covered Person’s health outcomes.
3. **“MTM Covered Person”** For purposes of the Prime MTMP Network, MTM Covered Person means a qualified, enrolled, and active participant in the MTMP. An MTM Covered Person may be enrolled a CMS Medicare Part D Benefit Sponsor. Qualification in the MTMP may be determined by Prime or the Benefit Sponsor based upon an individual’s medication utilization and health history, or other qualifications as determined by Prime.
4. **“MTM System”** means the management system built by Prime to deliver MTMP.
5. **“MTMP”** means Medication Therapy Management Program, which is a service that utilizes healthcare professionals and systems to provide clinical outcomes to MTM Covered Persons.
6. **“MTM Prescription Drug Service”** means a Prescription Drug Service dispensed to a MTM Covered Person as a result of a DUR under this MTMP.
7. **“Prime MTM Network”** means the network of pharmacies, including Pharmacy, which has entered into an agreement to provide MTMP services to MTM Covered Persons.
8. **“Program Effective Date”** means the date the MTMP begins for a particular Benefit Sponsor.
9. **“Program Expiration Date”** means the date that a particular Benefit Sponsor or Prime ends its sponsorship of its applicable MTMP.
